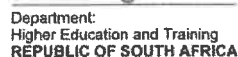

SCOPE OF WORK

1. PROJECT OVERVIEW

The project involves the supply, installation, repair, and upgrading of infrastructure elements for Workshop 1 and Workshop 2. This includes doors, windows, roofing, ceiling installation, air conditioning, and security enhancements.

2. SCOPE DETAILS

2.1 Doors Supply and Installation

The contractor shall supply and install the following doors:

- 2 x Main doors (Workshop 1 and Workshop 2)
- 2 x Office doors
- 2 x Store room doors

Requirements:

- Doors must be durable and suitable for workshop use
- Include all frames, hinges, locks, and fittings
- Proper alignment and secure installation required

2.2 Windows Supply, Installation, and Repairs

The contractor shall supply, install, or repair all windows in both workshops:

Specific windows:

- 1 x Workshop 1 office window

- 1 x Workshop 2 office window
- 1 x Store room 1 window
- 2 x Workshop 1 windows
- 2 x Workshop 2 windows

Additionally:

- Inspect and address all existing windows in both workshops
- Replace or repair damaged window components where necessary

2.3 Security Installation (Burglar Guards)

- Supply and install burglar guards on all workshop windows
- Guards must be:
 - Strong and tamper-resistant
 - Properly fitted and secured to window frames
 - Finished with anti-rust coating or paint

2.4 Ceiling Installation (QCTO Compliance)

- Supply, deliver and install 12.5mm RhinoBoard ceiling on galvanised steel/timber bracker, suspended from soffit with hangers, including jointing, skimming, sanding, and painting complete.

Requirements:

- Use high-quality ceiling board materials
- Include suspension system and finishing
- Ensure a neat, level, and professional finish

2.5 Air Conditioning Installation

The contractor shall supply and install air conditioning units as follows:

- 2 x Air conditioning units for main workshops
- 2 x Air conditioning units for office areas

Requirements:

- Units must be appropriately sized for the space
- Include mounting, piping, electrical connections, and testing
- Ensure proper airflow and positioning

2.6 Roof Repairs and Maintenance

The contractor shall carry out roof repairs, including:

- Replacement of damaged roof tiles
- Repair of roof leaks
- Sealing and closing any gaps in the roof structure

Requirements:

- Ensure complete waterproofing of repaired areas
- Use matching or suitable replacement materials
- Conduct testing to confirm no leakage

2.7 Epoxy Flooring

2.7.1 Base Coat

- Apply first coat of epoxy resin uniformly
- Ensure proper thickness and coverage

2.7.2 Intermediate Coat (if required)

- Apply build-up coat to achieve desired thickness
- Broadcast aggregates (silica sand or decorative flakes) where specified

2.7.3 Top Coat / Finish Coat

- Apply final epoxy or polyurethane topcoat for durability and finish
- Provide smooth, slip-resistant, or textured finish as specified
- Achieve uniform color and gloss (matt/satin/gloss depending on specification)

3. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- All materials must be new and of high quality
- Workmanship must comply with industry standards
- Site must be kept clean and safe at all times
- Contractor to provide all tools, labour, and equipment
- All installations must be fully functional upon completion

4. HANDOVER REQUIREMENTS

- All installations tested and operational
- Site cleaned and cleared of debris
- Any defects to be rectified before final handover

5. TIMEFRAME

(To be agreed with contractor prior to commencement)

6. HEALTH & SAFETY

- Contractor must comply with all safety regulations
- Proper PPE must be used at all times
- Work must not pose risk to occupants or infrastructure

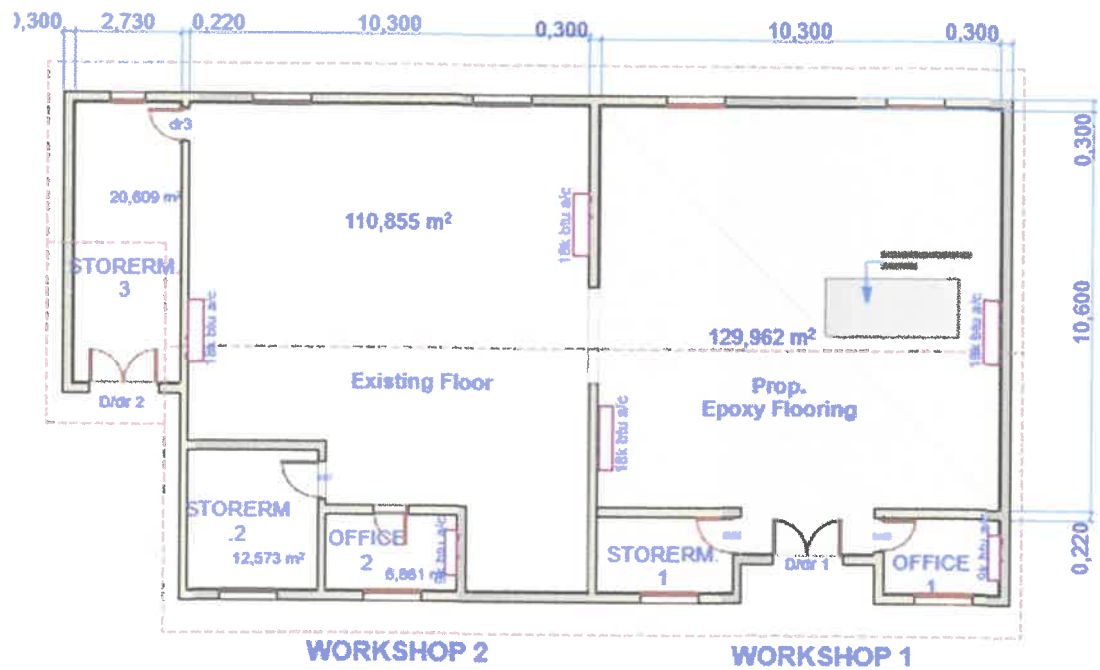
